#### Captain Paul Yep's Message

Wednesday, June 14, 2017

Recently, several victims have reported that they were scammed out of up to thousands of dollars from fraudulent phone callers.

Here are some common consumer phone and computer scam scenarios:

#### **IRS Scam**

The scam artist calls and pretends to be an official from the IRS. The caller may say you have overdue taxes and an arrest warrant has been issued or will be issued. You must pay with a pre-paid debit card/gift card or wire transfer money immediately to avoid being arrested.

#### The IRS:

- Will never demand immediate payment via gift card or wire transfer payment.
- Will not call about taxes owed without first mailing a bill.
- Will give you the opportunity to question or appeal the amount owed.
- Will not threaten to bring in local police or other law enforcement groups to have you arrested for not paying.

#### **PG&E Scam**

The scam artist calls and claims that your PG&E bill was past due and you have a few minutes to pay, otherwise the crew outside will turn off your power. The caller demands you to go to a store and purchase prepaid cards and provide the identification numbers printed on the card.

#### PG&E:

- Will not demand immediate payment via gift card or wire transfer payment.
- Any concern of legitimacy, contact PG&E directly.

#### **Mystery Shopper Scam**

A pop-up window appears on your computer screen offering mystery shopper jobs. Here's an example: You'll be asked to provide some personal information to get started. They will send you a cashier's check for \$1,500.00 and you are instructed to deposit the check to activate your employment. You are told to keep \$300.00 as advanced payment to cover initial expenses and to wire back the remainder of the money.

#### Mystery Shopper:

- Never wire money to someone you don't know.
- Never deposit a check from someone you don't know.

#### Incidents of Note

#### San Francisco Police Make Arrest in Northern District Homicide

On June 2, 2017 at 2:18 AM, San Francisco Police officers responded to the 2500 block of Van Ness Avenue regarding an unconscious male that was a victim of an assault. Upon arrival, the officers found the victim, Matthew Bate, a 33 year old Australian citizen, suffering from severe head trauma. San Francisco Fire Department paramedics responded and rendered aid, but unfortunately Bate succumbed to his injuries at San Francisco General Hospital.

Based on information and evidence immediately obtained at the scene, officers located and detained a possible suspect inside a hotel on the 2500 block of Van Ness Avenue. San Francisco Police Homicide Investigators were notified and began an investigation. At the conclusion of an interview with the detainee, it was determined this individual was responsible for Bate's murder. The suspect was identified as David Murillo, a 34 year old Hesperia, California resident. Murillo was booked into San Francisco County Jail on a felony charge of murder.



#### Kidnapping – 1 Embarcadero – 05/22/17, 0930

Officers responded to the Ferry Building regarding the Kidnapping of a three year old boy. Citizens had detained the female suspect, pinning her down on the floor until the police arrived. Central Station Officers spoke to several witnesses and reunited the child with his mother. The Suspect was taken into custody by the Officers.

#### Burglary Hotel – Assault with Poison – Sutter Street – 05/22/2017, 1500

A businessman from Singapore staying at a local Hotel exchanged phone numbers with two females he met a bar. The Suspects claimed to be visiting from Dallas, Texas. Later that evening, the two females contacted the businessman and they agreed to meet for a drink in his hotel room. After consuming his drink and agreeing to a back massage, the Victim woke up the next afternoon to discover his expensive wrist watch and cell phone had been stolen and the women nowhere to be found.

#### Vehicle Burglary - 100 Block of Bay Street - 05/31/17, 1841

A Suspect walked westbound on Bay Street casing vehicles to burglarize. Unaware that the Central Station Plainclothes Officers were keenly observing his unusual behavior, the suspect broke into a vehicle and removed several bags of property. Officers arrested the suspect with the stolen property still in his possession and returned the property to the owners.



#### Traffic Collision, Hit & Run - 05/27/17, 1734

Multiple witnesses observed a vehicle accident where a car lost control and hit a concrete planter box in the Union Square area. A witness followed the driver and passenger as they got out of the vehicle and ran away from the scene towards Market Street. Officers with the assistance of this witness, located, apprehended and arrested the driver on 4th Street.

This month, we interviewed Officer Minh Du, a 9-year member of Central Police Station.




Officer Minh Du was born in Vietnam. He came to California when he was young and attended George Washington High School After high school, he attended San Francisco State University.
