## Captain Paul Yep's Message

In its October 2016 review of the San Francisco Police Department policies and practices, the U.S. Department of Justice Collaborative Reform Initiative's report recommended "The City and County of San Francisco should strongly consider deploying ECWs (electronic control weapons; i.e., Tasers)" as a potential means of reducing officer-involved shootings and reducing injury to community members and officers.

At the June 21, 2017 meeting of the San Francisco Police Commission, Police Chief William Scott presented the following key points regarding ECWs (also known as Conducted Energy Devices, or CEDs) and the department's multi-pronged strategy for incorporating such devices while addressing public concerns:

- SFPD is dedicated to deploying the best policies and practices to ensure effective law enforcement services in the safest manner possible.
- Independent research has shown CEDs decrease the risk of injury to all parties involved in a police encounter where force is used.
  - ◊ DOJ has found that the use of CEDs is associated nationally with a decrease in citizen injury of 60%.
  - ◊ DOJ has found that the use of CEDs "carries with it a risk as low as or lower than most alternatives."
- Officers need an additional intermediate force option
  - ◊ DOJ has found that physical force options (e.g. baton, hand strikes) are associated with increased risk of injury to citizens of 50% and to officers of 300%.
  - ◊ CEDs provide an intermediate option while reducing the likelihood of injury to all parties.

- SFPD has a duty to decrease injury to citizens and to its employees to the extent reasonably possible. CEDs are tools that demonstrably achieve those goals without exposing the community to significant known risk.
- SFPD has maintained that it will comply with all DOJ recommendations regarding the Department. DOJ data overwhelmingly supports the use and deployment of CEDs.

The SFPD understands and acknowledges the public's concerns:

- 1) Studies show CEDs are used nationally disproportionately against people of color and those with mental health issues.
- 2) CEDs can lead to deaths.
- 3) CEDs often don't work.
- 4) CEDs appear to be incompatible with de-escalation principles.

Community concerns should be tempered with the known data and research available:

- 1) While CEDs nationally are used disproportionately against people of color, the DOJ's review of SFPD found no correlation between the severity of force used and the citizen's race. CEDs are a force option like any other: SFPD will continue to monitor all uses of force and ensure that force is deployed only when necessary and appropriate. In accordance with DOJ recommendations, SFPD has improved its data collection techniques and supervisory oversight to ensure that uses of force are effectively monitored.
- 2) CEDs can lead to death, but so can any use of force. DOJ found that CEDs pose no heightened risk of death or serious injury as compared to other less-lethal force options.
- 3) No force option is effective 100 percent of the time. It's important to compare the efficacy of the devices with other force options. On the greater weight of the published scientific evidence, the CED has the highest effectiveness rating compared to other less than lethal force options. Other options are more likely to have a lower probability of effectiveness and higher probability of injury to the subject and the officer. According to the Mesloh study, the CED in the first application has a higher probability of success than other less than lethal force options. That effectiveness rises to 81 percent more successful over other less than lethal force options in its third application.
- 4) CEDs are entirely compatible with de-escalation principles: they are merely an additional tool to be used *in conjunction* with de-escalation techniques. CEDs are a force option, like any other, the use of which shall be permitted only in accordance with a strict policy. SFPD is committed to de-escalation principles and deploying a new technology alongside that strategy is the most effective way to ensure SFPD personnel learn how to effectively use both.

The SFPD intends to address the public's concerns and minimize negative outcomes by using a multi-pronged strategy that includes:

- 1) A comprehensive policy
- 2) Robust training
- 3) Strong supervision
- 4) Extensive oversight and accountability measures.





# Central District, Theft from Vehicle June 1, 2017 - June 15, 2017 (186 Incidents)





## Incidents of Note

### Exhibiting a Deadly Weapon, Road Rage - **Clay & Taylor Street** - 06/01/17, 11:48 pm

Officers responded to the area of Clay & Hyde Streets on the report of male with a gun pointing it at several drivers. Upon arriving in the area, officers were unable to locate the suspect. Eventually the officers located the vehicle as the suspect turned into his residence. The officers located several **weapons and ammunition**. The suspect was placed under arrest.



### Burglary Vehicle - **Clay & Front Street** - 06/02/17, 03:24 pm

A suspect walking northbound on Montgomery Street was casing vehicles unaware that Central Station Plainclothes Officers were observing his unusual behavior. Eventually the suspect located a vehicle, shattered the window and removed several bags of property. Officers arrested the suspect with the stolen property still in his possession and returned it to the owners.




### Possession of Firearm – **Unit block of Pleasant Street** – 06/09/17, 07:11 pm

Plainclothes Officers located and apprehended a suspect with a Felony warrant recently released from Psychiatric Emergency Services. Officers served a search warrant on the suspect's residence and discovered several firearms including an **extremely large amount of ammunition and a large volume of highly explosive fireworks**. The suspect was placed under arrest.



### Aggravated Assault, Elder abuse – 700 block of Kearny Street – 06/09/17, 08:21 pm

Central Station Officers responded to the area of Portsmouth Square where a male was **swinging a stick** at bystanders in the area. Officers located and detained the suspect and were able to locate two victims who positively identified the suspect. One victim was injured and treated at the scene by paramedics. The suspect was taken into custody and placed under arrest.



### Firearm Arrest – Larkin / Broadway – 6/18/17, 04:33 am

A Ford Fusion traveling southbound on Hyde failed to use his turn signal. On approach, the officers smelled the odor of marijuana and conducted a search of the vehicle. They discovered not only contraband drugs/narcotics, but also a fully **loaded Glock 27 .40 Caliber** firearm. The suspect was arrested and booked on multiple weapons related charges as well as a possession of narcotics.

### Warrant Arrest – 1100 block of California – 6/14/17, 02:33 am

Officers responded to Grace Cathedral regarding a potential suicidal male in possession of a pellet gun. Upon arrival, Officers confronted an extremely upset male who was grieving over the death of his dog. Officers were able to talk the suspect into complying, which resulted in no one being injured. Officers retrieved **the blue plastic pellet gun** and the suspect was booked on an outstanding no bail felony warrant from CDC for a parole violation.



**Warrant Arrest - 700 block of Kearny Street - 06/13/17, 07:53 am**

Central Station Officers responded to the area of Portsmouth Square where a male was **swinging a machete** around. Upon arrival, Officers located and detained the suspect and were able to locate the machete. A computer check revealed that the suspect had several outstanding warrants. The suspect was taken into custody and placed under arrest.

**Malicious Mischief Vandalism - Washington Street - 06/13/17, 03:46 pm**

Central Station Officers responded to the area of Geary & Leavenworth Streets where a male was vandalizing a crosswalk signal box with a **metal pipe**. Upon arrival, Officers made several attempts to get the suspect to drop the metal pipe, but the suspect refused and ran away. Officers followed and continued to talk to the suspect to de-escalate the situation, but with no success. Finally after the deployment of an ERIW (Extended Range Impact Weapon), a “bean bag” gun, the suspect dropped the pipe and was taken into custody and placed under arrest.
